With many banner campaigns, participation in alternative tournaments and the organisation of alternative tournaments, the club's internal commitment to refugees, memberships in the association "Football Fans against Homophobia" and in the alliance "Halle gegen Rechts – Bündnis für Zivilcourage" and the cooperation with the university group "Amnesty International Halle", we lend weight to our attitude.

We demand in particular that our own members implement the above-mentioned principles of Rote Stern Halle during training and matches in their dealings with their own players, opponents and referees.

Information requirements according to Article 13 and 14 DSGVO

According to Articles 13 and 14 of the EU GDPR, the controller must provide a data subject whose data it processes with the information referred to in the Articles. This leaflet fulfils this obligation to provide information.

1. the name and contact details of the controller and, where applicable, its representatives:

2. purposes for which personal data are processed:

The personal data is processed for the implementation of the membership relationship (e.g. invitation to meetings, collection of membership fees, organisation of sports activities). Furthermore, personal data will be forwarded to the regional associations for participation in competitions, tournaments and games. In addition, personal data will be published in connection with sporting events, including reporting on them on the website of the club, in the club's appearances in social media and on the pages of the professional associations, and transmitted to local, regional and national print media.

3. legal bases on which the processing is carried out:

As a rule, the processing of personal data is carried out on the basis of necessity for the fulfilment of a contract in accordance with Article 6 para. 1 lit. b) DSGVO. The contractual relationships are primarily the membership relationship in the club and the participation in the games of the professional associations. If personal data is collected without the processing being necessary for the fulfilment of the contract, the processing is based on consent pursuant to Article 6 (1) a) in conjunction with Article 7 DSGVO. The publication of personal data on the internet or in local, regional or national print media is done to protect the legitimate interests of the association (cf. Article 6 para. 1 lit. f) DSGVO). The legitimate interest of the association is to inform the public by reporting on the activities of the association. In this context, personal data including pictures of the participants are published, for example, in the context of reporting on sporting events of the association.

4. the recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data:

Personal data of members who participate in the games and competitions of the national associations will be passed on to the respective national association for the purpose of acquiring a licence, a scorecard, a player pass or other entitlement to participate.

5. the duration for which the personal data will be stored or, if this is not possible, the criteria for determining the duration:

The personal data will be stored for the duration of the membership. Upon termination of membership, the data categories are retained for a further ten years in accordance with the statutory retention periods and then deleted. In the period between termination of membership and deletion, the processing of this data is restricted. Certain categories of data are stored in the association archive for the purpose of the association's chronicle. These are the categories first name, last name, membership of a team, special sporting successes or events in which the person concerned has participated. The storage is based on a justified interest of the club in the contemporary documentation of sporting events and successes and the respective composition of the teams. All data of the other categories (e.g. address, contact details) are deleted upon termination of membership.

6. The data subject shall have the following rights under the conditions set out in each of the Articles:

- the right to information pursuant to Article 15 of the GDPR,
- the right of rectification under Article 16 of the GDPR,
- the right to erasure in accordance with Article 17 of the GDPR,
- the right to restriction of processing under Article 18 of the GDPR,
- the right to data portability in accordance with Article 20 of the GDPR,
- the right to object in accordance with Article 21 of the GDPR,
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority pursuant to Article 77 of the GDPR
- the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent until withdrawal.

7. the source from which the personal data originated:

Personal data is generally collected in the course of acquiring membership.
